### Our Staff Requirements

Peace Lutheran Preschool classes will be taught by a lead teacher and an assistant teacher based on enrollment/state requirements. Together they will carry out the daily activities of the preschool. Our director and teachers must meet the requirements for preschool teaching as mandated by the state of AZ. They have experience working with children in a variety of environments. They are committed Christian leaders who see their occupation not just as a job, but as a calling and a ministry to children. **All teachers have been accredited by the Evangelical Lutheran Education Association.**

### Our Church

Peace Lutheran Church is a division of the Grand Canyon Synod and a member of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America (E.L.C.A.). **Our mission statement: To share Christ with the world and grow disciples for Jesus.**

### Chapel

**Once a week**, Pastor Al will share a Bible story and prayer with the children in the sanctuary. **Once a month, parents will attend chapel with their student.**

### Snack

Parents are required to provide a snack for their student each day. Snacks should be in a large Ziploc bag with their student's first and last name. **PLP will provide napkins and water for drinking at snack time.**

### Transportation

It is the responsibility of the parent to provide the transportation to and from the preschool. **Any children left unattended in a car while on the church premises are considered at risk of child endangerment by the state of AZ. As an agent of the state, it will be the duty of PLP to report these incidences to the Department of Child Protective Services of the state of AZ.**

### Signing Your Child In

**Peace Lutheran Preschool hours are from 9:15 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.** Prior to the beginning of the preschool day, teachers are very busy preparing their classrooms for the children. We ask that you bring your child to the playground if you arrive early. The doors from the playground will be opened at 9:10 a.m. for admission. You must escort your child to their classroom. The teacher will greet you at the door and ask you to sign your child in for the day. You are encouraged to say goodbye at the door. We understand that some children will have difficulty, particularly during the first few days of school. Short goodbyes are always the best in this situation. **You must sign your complete signature, print the child's name, and record the time signed in.**

### Hours of Operation

**All classes are operated from 9:15 a.m. until 12:00 p.m.**

(Afternoon class times to be announced when offered)

**Sack Pack program operated from 12:00 p.m. until 1:30 p.m.**

(Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday)

### Sack Pack

An extended day program that operates Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, & Friday for all children attending AM classes at PLP is available. **Sack Pack follows the regular preschool curriculum from 12:00 p.m. to 1:30 p.m.**
